APPLICANTS NEED TO BE BETWEEN THE AGES OF 18-28, WITH RIGHT-TO-WORK DOCUMENTS. HOPE BUILDERS CASTS A WIDE NET TO RECRUIT AS MANY APPLICANTS AS POSSIBLE. WE CAREFULLY VET AND SCREEN EACH APPLICANT TO IDENTIFY THOSE WHO ARE MOTIVATED, MOST LIKELY TO COMPLETE THE PROGRAM, ANDEXCITED TO START BUILDING THEIR CAREER. APPLICANTS, WHO COMPLETE ALL STEPS OF THE PROCESS, ARE INVITED TO ORIENTATION. 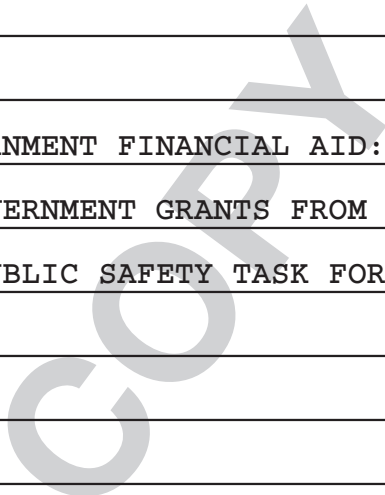

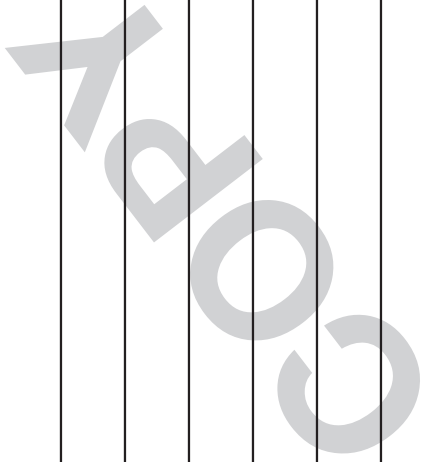
